MINUTES: Motion Bailey support Madigan to approve the minutes of May 11, 2010 with amendments requested by Committee Member Miller. **MOTION CARRIED.**

CORRESPONDENCE: NONE

REPORTS: Committee Chairperson Miazga, reported on his participation in a ride-along. Committee person Wardwell discussed his visit to the dog pound with the Animal Control Officer. Mr. Wardwell also witnessed preparation of the boat for the Memorial Holiday weekend. Committee person Miller attended a Community Policing Program and also participated in a ride-along with the fire department personnel. Committee member Wardwell also advised that he recently attended the CCW/CPL training class. Member Madigan attended roll call after the injury accident involving an on-duty police officer and also attended a Community Policing Program.

At the request of Committee Member Miller, Old Business and New Business were scheduled in reverse format.

OLD BUSINESS: A copy of the PS Committee Non-Binding Resolution Number 2010-001 was read by Chairperson Miazga. Prepared written statements were read by Madigan and Miller. Motion Wardwell support Miazga to accept the resolution as presented. Moening gave an overview on the Marine Patrol on Belleville Lake, Memorial Weekend, 2010. Officer Adam Byrd updated the committee and audience regarding the Community Policing Program on both past and present community policing activities. Officer Byrd advised the committee that Benny Napoleon will be present at the July 7th meeting. Motion Miazga, support Wardwell to have the meeting "live" on July 7, 2010.
