Thank you for your letter of September 7, 2011 advising of Visteon's decision to market for sale the Grace Lake Corporate Center located within Van Buren Township. The continued presence of Visteon as a member of the Van Buren business community is well received.

The Grace Lake Corporate Center is a most important business center in the Township and a potential change in its ownership is of keen interest to the Township to ensure it will continue to be developed and managed as a first class facility with tenants contributing to the overall economic welfare of the Township.

Accordingly, we request that we not only be kept advised of the progress of locating a suitable purchaser but also when that investor is identified and negotiations commence to finalize the sale, that the Township be invited to have representatives attend those sessions. We believe a Township presence is important to develop a working relationship with a new owner immediately at the outset, to confirm the Township's expectations and interest in assisting in the development of the corporate center and to advise of the obligations being assumed by a new owner pursuant to, for example, the January 25, 2010 Agreement and Mutual Release between Visteon and the Township.

The Township's participation in this process is, in essence, a continuation of a relationship between us which resulted in Visteon's selection of the Township as the corporate site for its business and the Township's assistance in making that location a reality.
